Sunday Readings

Lecturas Dominicales

Primera lectura – Hechos 15:1-2, 22-29: Los apóstoles decidieron no imponer la circuncisión a los creyentes gentiles, pero les pidieron que evitaran ciertas prácticas. Enviaron una carta con representantes para confirmar esta decisión.

Salmo responsorial – **Salmo 67:** Que Dios nos bendiga y guíe a las naciones, para que todos los pueblos lo alaben con alegría y respeten sus caminos.

Segunda lectura – Apocalipsis 21:10-14, 22-23: El ángel me mostró Jerusalén, resplandeciente con la gloria de Dios. Tenía doce puertas y cimientos, cuyos nombres corresponden a las tribus de Israel y a los apóstoles. Dios y el Cordero son su templo y su luz.

Evangelio – Juan 14:23-29: Jesús promete que el Espíritu Santo nos enseñará y recordará sus palabras. Deja su paz y nos dice que no temamos, preparándonos para su regreso al Padre.

Mass Readings

First Reading – Acts 15:1-2, 22-29: The apostles decided not to burden Gentile believers with circumcision but asked them to avoid certain practices. They sent a letter with representatives to confirm this decision.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 67: May God bless us and guide the nations, so all peoples praise Him with joy and respect His ways.

Second Reading – Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23: The angel showed me Jerusalem, shining with God's glory. It had twelve gates and foundations named after the tribes of Israel and apostles. God and the Lamb are its temple and light.

Gospel – John 14:23-29: Jesus promises the Holy Spirit will teach and remind us of His words. He leaves His peace and tells us not to be afraid, preparing us for His return to the Father.
