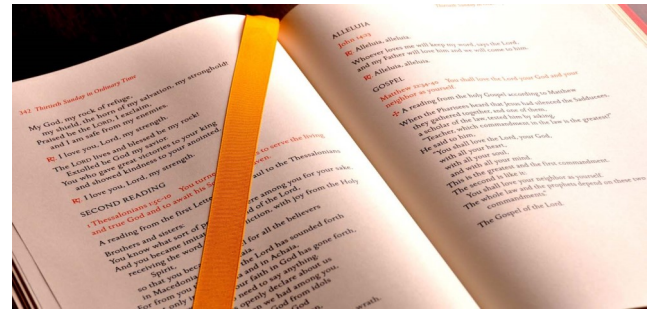

MASS READINGS

First Reading – Genesis 18:20-32: God tells Abraham He will check on Sodom and Gomorrah's sin. Abraham asks God to spare the city if ten innocent people are found, and God agrees.

Responsorial Psalm – Psalm 138: I thank the Lord for hearing my prayers, giving me strength, and protecting me. His kindness lasts forever, and He will complete His work for me.

Second Reading – Colossians 2:12-14: In baptism, you were buried and raised with Christ. God forgave your sins, canceled your debt, and made you alive with Christ.

Gospel – Luke 11:1-13: Jesus teaches His disciples how to pray and emphasizes persistence in prayer, assuring them that God will answer. He highlights God's readiness to give the Holy Spirit to those who ask.

LECTURAS DOMINICALES

Primera Lectura – Génesis 18:20-32: Dios le dice a Abraham que investigará el pecado de Sodoma y Gomorra. Abraham le pide a Dios que perdone la ciudad si encuentra a diez inocentes, y Dios accede.

Salmo Responsorial – Salmo 138: Doy gracias al Señor por escuchar mis oraciones, darme fuerza y protegerme. Su bondad es eterna y Él completará su obra por mí.

Segunda Lectura – Colosenses 2:12-14: En el bautismo, fuiste sepultado y resucitado con Cristo. Dios perdonó tus pecados, canceló tu deuda y te dio vida con Cristo.

Evangelio – Lucas 11:1-13: Jesús enseña a sus discípulos a orar y enfatiza la perseverancia en la oración, asegurándoles que Dios responderá. Destaca la disposición de Dios para dar el Espíritu Santo a quienes lo piden.

Trusting God's Mercy and Care

The readings for the 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C highlight God's mercy and care for His people. In the first reading, Abraham intercedes for the people of Sodom, trusting in God's justice and compassion. In the Gospel, Jesus shows that we can ask God for what we need, confident in His love for us.

Abraham's boldness in speaking to God shows that we, too, can approach Him with our worries and hopes. God listens when we pray for others and seeks to help us in ways we may not always see. This reminds us to care deeply for others and to trust in God's kindness.

Jesus teaches that God provides good things to His children. Just as a parent meets the needs of their family, God hears our prayers and responds. This does not mean we always get what we ask for, but we can trust that God knows what is best for us.

Both readings remind us to trust in God's love and mercy, even in difficult times. They encourage us to pray with faith, knowing that God listens and cares deeply for us and for those we bring to Him in prayer.

As we reflect on these themes, we are reminded of the importance of prayer in every part of our lives. The 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C encourages us to trust God more fully, pray more sincerely, and rely on His love for guidance and strength.

Confiando en la Misericordia y el Cuidado de Dios

Las lecturas del 17.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Año C, resaltan la misericordia y el cuidado de Dios por su pueblo. En la primera lectura, Abraham intercede por los habitantes de Sodoma, confiando en la justicia y la compasión de Dios. En el Evangelio, Jesús muestra que podemos pedirle a Dios lo que necesitamos, confiados en su amor por nosotros.

La audacia de Abraham al hablar con Dios demuestra que también nosotros podemos acercarnos a él con nuestras preocupaciones y esperanzas. Dios escucha cuando oramos por los demás y busca ayudarnos de maneras que no siempre vemos. Esto nos recuerda que debemos cuidar profundamente a los demás y confiar en la bondad de Dios.

Jesús enseña que Dios provee cosas buenas a sus hijos. Así como un padre atiende las necesidades de su familia, Dios escucha nuestras oraciones y responde. Esto no significa que siempre obtengamos lo que pedimos, pero podemos confiar en que Dios sabe qué es lo mejor para nosotros.

Ambas lecturas nos recuerdan que debemos confiar en el amor y la misericordia de Dios, incluso en tiempos difíciles. Nos animan a orar con fe, sabiendo que Dios nos escucha y se preocupa profundamente por nosotros y por quienes le presentamos en oración.

Al reflexionar sobre estos temas, recordamos la importancia de la oración en cada aspecto de nuestra vida. El 17.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, Año C, nos anima a confiar más plenamente en Dios, a orar con más sinceridad y a confiar en su amor para recibir guía y fortaleza.
