**First Reading** – <u>2 Samuel 7:1-5, 8B-12, 14A, 16</u>: God responds to David's desire to build a temple, recounting His support and promising a lasting dynasty, establishing a peaceful kingdom and an everlasting throne for David's lineage.

**Responsorial Psalm** – <u>Psalm 89</u>: I will forever sing of the Lord's promises and steadfast kindness, as He has pledged an enduring covenant with David, ensuring his lineage and throne for all generations.

**Second Reading** – <u>Romans 16:25-27</u>: Glory to God, who strengthens us through the Gospel of Jesus Christ, revealing long-hidden mysteries, now shared with all nations to foster obedience of faith.

**Gospel** – <u>Luke 1:26-38</u>: The angel Gabriel, sent by God, greeted Mary in Nazareth, proclaiming she would conceive Jesus, the Son of the Most High. Troubled, Mary wondered how, being a virgin. Gabriel explained the Holy Spirit's role and mentioned Elizabeth's miraculous pregnancy, affirming God's power. Mary humbly accepted, declaring herself the Lord's servant.

# **Eight Days of Christmas Joy**

The Octave of Christmas is an eight-day celebration. It starts on Christmas Day and ends on January 1st. The Church celebrates the joy of Jesus' birth throughout these days.

December 26th is the Feast of St. Stephen. He was the first martyr of the Church. St. Stephen reminds us to stand firm in our faith. December 27th is the Feast of St. John the Apostle. He was one of Jesus' closest followers. St. John wrote one of the Gospels. He teaches us about love and truth. December 28th is the Feast of the Holy Innocents. These were the baby boys killed by King Herod. Herod wanted to kill baby Jesus. The Holy Innocents remind us of the sacrifice for Jesus. December 29th is the Feast of St. Thomas Becket. He was the Archbishop of Canterbury. St. Thomas stood up for the



Church's rights. He was martyred for his faith. The Sunday within the Octave, or if there is no Sunday, December 30th, is the <u>Feast of the Holy Family</u>. This feast honors Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as a family. It reminds us of the importance of family life. We look to the Holy Family as a model for our own families. January 1st is the <u>Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God</u>. This day honors Mary as the mother of Jesus. We celebrate her role in God's plan. It is also a day to pray for peace in the world.


