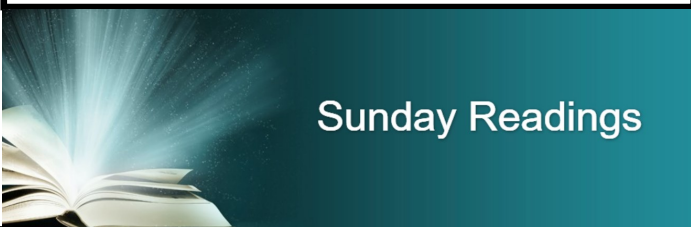
It is beautiful to take stock during this Easter season and see how our parish community has little by little been resurrected since the celebration of its Centennial in 2023. It would have seemed that everything was going to end there but no. Here is the general count of all the projects that have been carried out to date and their general cost:

- ◆ Painting of the Exterior and Interior of the Church and Parish buildings \$110,000
- ◆ Church and Rectory Roof \$ 52,000
- ◆ Pews—Refinishing \$ 44,000
- ◆ New Floor under Pews \$ 7,000
- ◆ **Coming up** “New Carpet” \$ 20,000

All projects have been approved by the financial and parish council before work has started.

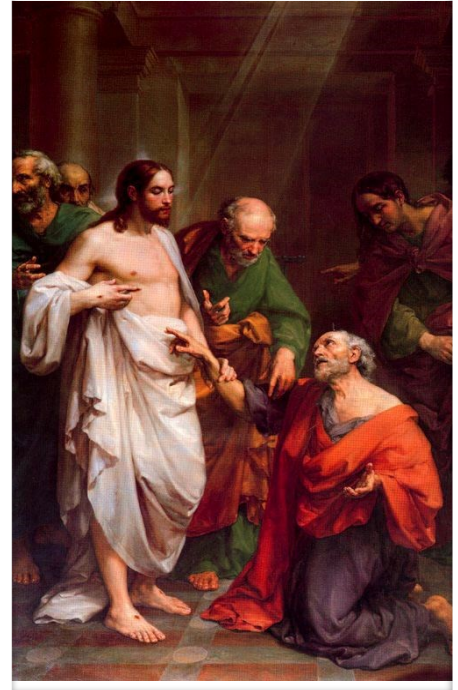
REFLEXION DEL EVANGELIO DE HOY

En Juan 20:19-31, encontramos dos momentos cruciales después de la resurrección de Jesús. La primera escena se desarrolla la tarde del día de la resurrección. Los discípulos, temiendo a las autoridades, se han encerrado en una habitación. De repente, Jesús aparece en medio de ellos, saludándolos con las palabras tranquilizadoras: "La paz esté con vosotros". (v21). Les muestra sus manos y su costado, brindándoles evidencia tangible de su identidad.

En la segunda escena escuchamos la historia de Tomás, uno de los discípulos, que estuvo ausente durante este encuentro. Cuando se le informó de la aparición de Jesús, expresó dudas y declaró que a menos que viera y tocara las heridas, no creería. Una semana después, Jesús aparece nuevamente, invitando a Tomás a tocar sus llagas. Abrumado, Tomás cree y exclama: "¡Señor mío y Dios mío!" y Jesús responde: "Bienaventurados los que sin haber visto han creído" (v29, NVI), reconociendo la fe de las generaciones futuras.

TODAY'S GOSPEL REFLEXION

In John 20:19-31, we find two pivotal moments in the aftermath of Jesus' resurrection. The first scene unfolds on the evening of the resurrection day. The disciples, fearing the authorities, have locked themselves in a room. Suddenly, Jesus appears in their midst, greeting them with the reassuring words, "Peace be with you." (v21). He shows them His hands and side, providing tangible evidence of His identity.



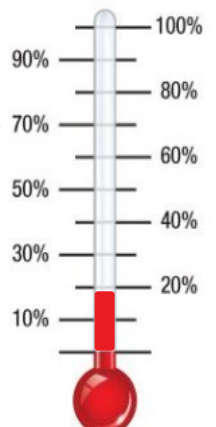
In the second scene we hear the story of Thomas, one of the disciples, who was absent during this encounter. When informed of Jesus' appearance, he expressed doubt, declaring that unless he saw and touched the wounds, he would not believe. A week later, Jesus appears again, inviting Thomas to touch His wounds. Overwhelmed, Thomas believes, exclaiming, "My Lord and my God!" and Jesus responds, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (v29, NIV), acknowledging the faith of future generations..
