

Mary's Role in God's Plan

The Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, is a special day to honor Mary's role in God's plan of salvation. Paul's letter to the Galatians tells us that God sent His Son, born of a woman, to redeem us. This woman is Mary, and through her, Jesus came into the world. Mary's acceptance of God's plan allowed the Word to become flesh. Jesus, both God and man, bridged the gap between us and God. This event fulfills ancient prophecies and shows God's great love for us. On the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God, we reflect on this mystery and what it means for us.

We also learn that we are adopted as God's children. Through Jesus, we are no longer bound by the law but are part of God's family. This adoption is more than a legal status; it is a call to a close relationship with God. We can call Him "Abba, Father" just like Jesus did.

The Mother of God, invites us to live as true children of God. We are called to recognize our new identity and live in the light of God's love. As we honor Mary, we are encouraged to deepen our relationship with God and follow her example of faith and obedience.



El papel de María en el plan de Dios

La Solemnidad de María, la Madre de Dios, es un día especial para honrar el papel de María en el plan de salvación de Dios. La carta de Pablo a los Gálatas nos dice que Dios envió a su Hijo, nacido de una mujer, para redimirnos. Esta mujer es María, y a través de ella, Jesús vino al mundo. La aceptación de María del plan de Dios permitió que la Palabra se hiciera carne. Jesús, Dios y hombre, cerró la brecha entre nosotros y Dios. Este evento cumple profecías antiguas y muestra el gran amor de Dios por nosotros. En la Solemnidad de María, la Madre de Dios, reflexionamos sobre este misterio y lo que significa para nosotros.

También aprendemos que somos adoptados como hijos de Dios. A través de Jesús, ya no estamos sujetos a la ley sino que somos parte de la familia de Dios. Esta adopción es más que un estatus legal; es un llamado a una relación cercana con Dios. Podemos llamarlo "Abba, Padre" tal como lo hizo Jesús.

La Madre de Dios nos invita a vivir como verdaderos hijos de Dios. Estamos llamados a reconocer nuestra nueva identidad y vivir a la luz del amor de Dios. Al honrar a María, se nos anima a profundizar nuestra relación con Dios y a seguir su ejemplo de fe y obediencia.
